Aims & Objectives

- To promote awareness and sensitivity about Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH) rights, information, education and services.

- To run public sector Health Care Facilities in order to establish delivery of primary Health care services to the local population.

- To makes recommendations for their effective implementation, undertakes and promotes research in the field of human rights, spreads human rights literacy among various sections of society and promotes awareness of the safeguards available for protecting these rights through publications, media, seminars and other.
